# ABOUT CHORUS PRO MUSICA

Chorus pro Musica has a superb reputation as one of the talented choruses of New England. Founded in 1949 by the late Alfred Nash Patterson, one of the most influential forces in choral music in New England, Chorus pro Musica quickly became known for its innovative programming and high-quality performances. The 100-member chorus, now led by the talented Jamie Kirsch, has performed with such famed organizations as the Boston Symphony Orchestra, the Boston Philharmonic, the New England Philharmonic, the Boston Ballet, the Pittsburgh Symphony Orchestra, and the Concert Opera Boston. Chorus pro Musica has two Grammy nominations for its collaboration with the Boston Symphony Orchestra on the RCA label. More recently, Jonathan Blumhofer of the Arts Fuse selected the chorus' performance of Gershwin's "Of Thee I Sing" as one of the top ten classical performances of 2017. The chorus has performed in Boston, Arlington, Cambridge, Newton, and other towns in the Greater Boston area in which the audience size ranges from 200-1,000 local residents.
